TRAFFIC SPEED IN THE VILLAGE

At the Annual Village Meeting, concern was again expressed about the speed of traffic in the village, both along the top road and down the village. Recent speed gun measurements showed an *average* speed of under 30 mph on the top road, but **some vehicles were travelling at well over 30 mph**. The Parish Council is negotiating with ERYC to make the speed limits clearer and to add a 40 mph buffer zone on the Driffield Road, but we all know where the limit is.

More dangerous is speed down Church Street past the **bus shelter**. We also all know that children play there, and even sensible adults sometimes have to take quick action to avoid speeding vehicles.

Please, would **PARENTS** remind children of the danger of playing in the road and encourage them to play safely on the Green; and **DRIVERS** moderate their speed.

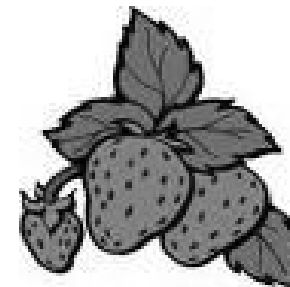
Co-option of Councillors
