We aim to continue working on the lower pond and green area, and then move on to the pit area and improving pedestrian access along the footpath from the Green.

The group is now properly constituted through ERVAS (East Riding Voluntary Action Services)

IT IS REALLY IMPORTANT THAT YOU RETURN COMPLETED QUESTIONNAIRES TO US.


Following analysis of the questionnaires, our next step will be to finalise recreational equipment proposals and costings and meet the ERVAS grant funding team.
