## CHEAPER ENERGY TOGETHER

ERYC has obtained a grant from the Department of Energy and Climate Change to set up a 'Cheaper Energy Together' collective switching scheme.

YORSwitch will hold an auction with energy suppliers to obtain cheaper energy prices for all East Riding residents who register. If you do register, there is no obligation to take up the offer, but the more who register, the greater the buying power and the better the offer could be.

No need to trawl through price comparison sites, YORSwitch does all the hard work for you.

Registration is now open, and closes on Monday 8th April. The auction will take place on 9th April and it is expected that offers will be received by 9th May.

# The East Riding Local Plan

The East Riding Local Plan is the set of planning documents that provide the framework for managing key planning issues and development in the East Riding. These include:

- A Strategy Document - sets the overall strategic direction for the Local Plan, with key policies to guide decisions on planning applications.
- An Allocations Document - allocates sites for development (eg housing, retail, or industry) or protection (eg open space or land for transport schemes).
- A Bridlington Town Centre Area Action Plan (AAP) - specific policies to guide the development and revival of Bridlington Town Centre.
- Policies Map – shows how space is designated for use, (eg areas of open space or biodiversity assets), and allocations for particular land uses (eg housing) identified in the specific policies of the Local Plan.
- A Joint Waste Plan – prepared collaboratively with Hull, this sets out the policies for future waste management needs
- A Joint Minerals Plan – prepared collaboratively with Hull, this sets out the policies for future minerals development

Linda and Gemma from Huggate Parish Council attended a consultation meeting organised by ERYC to discuss what the proposals mean for the East Riding. The key points are:

- A significant number of new houses is needed across the region to meet demand
- Any development which has 3 or more houses will have to make a contribution to providing affordable housing (between 5%-25%)
- In rural areas infill housing of 1 dwelling per application site will be allowed
- A Community Infrastructure Levy will be financed through development schemes
- Village Development Limits have been tightened to encourage infill development.

Have your say – **the consultation period will finish on Friday 5th April 2013** and the plan is to be adopted by the council by the end of 2014.
