December 5th—7th

**Driffield Road will be CLOSED
to through traffic between
Newby Farm and the North Dalton Road
for “approximately” 3 days,
beginning on 5th December.**

The road will be open at all times to emergency services, pedestrians and for access to properties directly affected by the closure but closed to through traffic.

The marked diversion will be via North Dalton and Warter.
